What you need to get started on your insulation project.



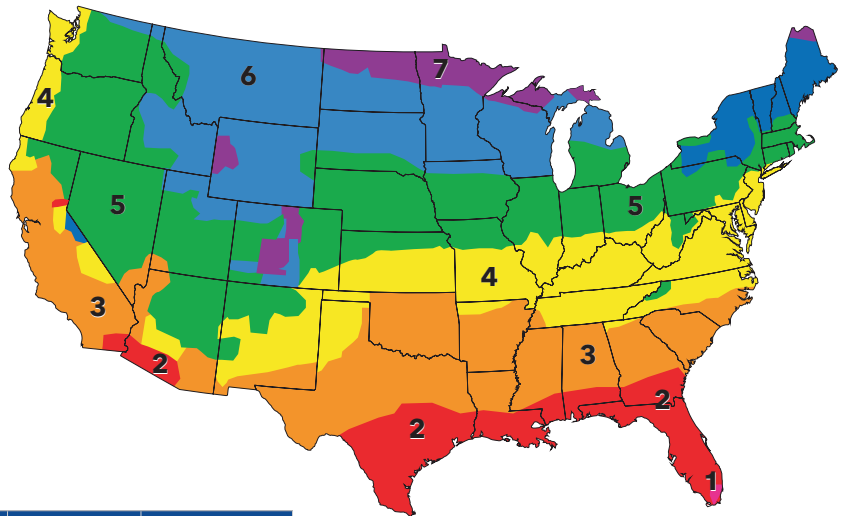
TOOLS NEEDED

- Gloves
- Utility knife
- Paper ruler or tape measure
- 2x4 piece of wood
- Protective eyewear
- Long-sleeved shirt
- Cardboard sheet to cut insulation on
- Caulk
- Attic light
- Canned foam
- Staple gun and staples
- Kneepads
- Screwdriver
- Mask



MEET RECOMMENDED R-VALUES

R stands for resistance to heat flow. The higher the R-Value, the greater the insulation power. As R-Value increases, so does energy efficiency and home comfort. The colder or warmer the climate, the higher R-Value needed to maintain energy efficiency and comfort.
